Lim Thiam Cheok, Lim Yam Chiew and Lim Yam Poh, being the siblings of Dr Lim Thian Soo are deemed substantial shareholders of D&O and are deemed shareholders in Dominant. Lim Yam Chiew, is also sister-in-law of Goh Nan Yang

The principal activity of Dominant is manufacturing of semiconductor components and machineries. Aeopto HK is an investment holding company that principally invests in semiconductor business in China.

The recurrent related party transactions are made in the ordinary course of business on normal commercial terms which are not more favourable to the related party than those generally available to the public. Additionally, Aeopto HK has benefitted from the price competitiveness and business efficiencies such as reliable supply, shorter delivery time and better service.
